Arrival: Dressing room spaces will be assigned for each group - please find yours and prepare to dance. If you have *not* volunteered and been assigned a position by the office in advance you will not be needed for this rehearsal and can drop your child off at the door. If you *have* volunteered we will need you for this rehearsal to practice costuming details and quick-changes - this is the only costumed opportunity before the show as tech rehearsal at the theater will be done in regular dance attire so it is very important that every cast member is in attendance.

Students should arrive wearing:

- A nude leotard (Boys may wear neutral shade fitted shorts & a tank top)
- pink tights
- Ballet slippers / pointe shoes
- Performance Hair Style (see hair & makeup guide below)
- Makeup is not necessary for In Studio Dress Rehearsal

Dismissal: Please wait until your child is finished & brought into the lobby by their helper. There will be no eating in costumes.

When: Saturday, December 16th

Where: The Stockbridge Theater - 5 Pinkerton Street, Derry, NH 03038 (On Pinkerton High Campus)

Arrival: Please enter through the lobby & sign your child in. If you have not volunteered and been assigned a position by the office in advance you will not be permitted backstage with your child. Additional volunteers are invited to contact nesdoffice@gmail.com in advance.

For tech rehearsal, students should arrive wearing:

- Regular ballet class attire with leggings / sweatpants & zip/button up sweater on over leo and tights for easy removal in the theater. Please no dance bags or additional belongings.
- Clean ballet shoes (Please see tights & shoes guide in Performance Package, sent in Oct) please keep your child's street shoes and jacket with you for pick-up.
- Exact performance hair style (See Hair & Stage Makeup Guide below)
- NO jewelry, NO nail polish or fake nails
- Makeup is not necessary for tech rehearsal but <u>must be fully complete for performance</u> <u>call time (see schedule below)</u>

Dismissal: Students will be escorted out to the lobby at their dismissal time & must be signed out before leaving. Please wait in the sign in/out area until your child arrives with their helper after finishing. <u>Please make sure your child eats an energizing meal between tech & performance call time.</u> We will have light, mess free snacks for the children in their dressing rooms but there will not be time for meals or additional food while backstage. The only people permitted to bring their own snack are those with an allergy and this should be communicated to our office in advance.

Returning for the Performance:

Students must arrive at show call time wearing:

- A **nude** leotard & clean pink tights underneath with leggings / sweatpants & zip/button up sweater on over leo and tights for easy removal in the theater.
- Boys may wear neutral shade fitted shorts & a tank top
- Clean ballet / pointe shoes
- Exact performance hair style <u>completed</u> (see Hair & Makeup guide below)
- Fully completed stage makeup
- A small labeled dance bag with extra bobbi pins, red lipstick & any necessary makeup for touch ups, mini hairspray for frizz, extra pair of pink tights
- A full water bottle
- The only thing left for our volunteers to do should be to help your child put their costume on & get them settled and ready to perform!
