Choosing a Training Track for Your Child

Passionate Track Students:

Ages 2.5 and older

Our youngest passionate students (ages 2.5-6) take 1-2 classes per week to experience the movement, rhythm & creative beauty of dance. Passionate students ages 7+ will take 2-4 classes per week to develop a dance foundation while enjoying a variety of styles such as ballet, jazz, tap, musical theater, hip hop & modern. At least one ballet class is highly recommended for the student to learn body placement, alignment, musicality, balance, upper body carriage & more with the American Ballet Theater's National Training Curriculum. Elementary through Advanced level ballet students will perform at least one class piece in our annual Nutcracker Production and are highly encouraged to audition for additional roles. All Passionate students will perform in our annual Spring Production! We believe dancing is for everybody and leads to happy, confidently well-rounded kids!

Performance Track:

Ages 5 and older

The NESD&T Performance Track is for dancers who are motivated to thrive in class & on stage! These students will take ballet & a variety of other classes designed to help them grow into strong, versatile artists! Performance Track students will audition for and perform in our annual Nutcracker & Spring Productions and are highly encouraged to audition for our Performing Company to represent NESD&T at local & national competitions & festivals. Students ages 5-8 will take 3+ classes per week (At least one ballet or ballet combo class) and students ages 8+ will take 5+ classes (At least one ballet class) per week. Committing to our performance track is about more than just dancing - it's about being a part of a community where we learn life skills such as teamwork, dedication, focus, passion, musicality, self-expression, perseverance and so much more!

Pre-Professional Track:

Ages 5+

A Pre-Professional student will be interested in training to prepare for a career in the field of dance & the performing arts. These students will take 6-10 hours per week, be a member of our Performing Company & schedule a weekly private lesson to strengthen & refine their technique, artistry & choreography for competitions & performances. Theater Division

Ages 6 and older

Our Theater division combines the worlds of theater & dance education with classes in acting, singing & dance. Aspiring singers & actors will strengthen their versatility by adding dance to their repertoire. Dancers will broaden their horizons with an expanded curriculum featuring fundamentals of acting & singing. Through our dynamic and inclusive programming, along with our extensive knowledge in theater education & performance opportunities, dancers & actors alike will surely find that their creativity will flourish here at NESD&T! Theater Showcases highlighting scenes & songs from select hit musicals will be presented by our Monday and Friday Acting & Singing classes each trimester! Students in these classes are encouraged to choose from the many dance classes offered at NESD&T. Ordering Your NESD&T Uniform

Corps Dancewear is now the provider of our official dress code leotards, skirts and men's shirts! These high quality leotards are fully lined and durable, imprinted with our school logo and available in a variety of classical styles.

After completing your enrollment, review the attached dress code guide and corresponding Welcome Packet. Once you've confirmed which items your student will need to meet NESD&T's dress code for various class styles, complete the Dress Code Order Form which is now online and was sent out via email in August. You'll choose between leotard colors and styles within each level, skirts, tights and more! Please ensure that your desired payment method is up-to-date on your Studio Director account. Once your payment is processed, confirmation of your order and an estimated arrival date will be communicated - our office will contact you as soon as items are at the studio for you! In the meantime, if your dancer has class(es) prior to the arrival of this shipment please bring them to class in any dance wear you currently have that comes closest to meeting our dress code; you do not need to purchase any additional new tights and leotards locally if you don't wish to - we will be flexible with the dress code during the first two weeks of classes as we know the delivery is not guaranteed before September 5th. If you're new to our studio and you do wish to purchase a \$5 gently used leotard from Turning Pointe Boutique in our lobby for the meantime, your donation would support the performing company members at NESD&T. Representatives from the non-profit booster club will be available at open house to assist (cash or Venmo payments accepted).

September 9th Audition Schedule:

Ages 5-10: Nutcracker Audition: 12:15-1:15 (Ballet) & *Optional* Performing Company Audition: 1:15-1:45 in Jazz, Contemporary/Lyrical & Tap to follow for those interested in competing with our Performing Company groups.

Ages11+: Nutcracker Audition: 2:30-3:30 (Ballet & Pointe) & *Optional* Performing Company Audition: 3:30-4:30 in Jazz, Contemporary/Modern & Tap for those interested in competing with our PC groups.

The cost of the Nutcracker audition is \$25.00 per dancer or \$40 per family (Performing Company Audition is included free of charge)
