

Inspired most by her first teacher and mother, Susan Case, Alison is proud to serve as Artistic Director at the New England School of Dance & Theater. She encourages every student to believe in themselves and embrace a lifelong love of learning.



Synopsis

The Nutcracker is a two Act ballet created in 1892 and adapted from the ETA Hoffman story, "The Nutcracker and the Mouse King." It was originally choreographed by Maurius Pepita and Lev Ivanov, with a musical score by Tchaikovsky. 




